

# July 13, 2015

## BOARD MEETING

A Town Board Meeting was called to order on July 13, 2015 by Chairman Gene Huth. Roll call was taken. Present were Huth, Supervisor Canfield, Supervisor Reinart, treasurer Shawn Huth, clerk Donna Kuhn, and 3 residents. The agenda was legally noticed and approved.

The minutes from last month's meeting were read by the clerk and approved. Treasurer's report was read and accepted. Treasurer presented a proposal by the County to contract a company to run tax batches per a computer program for \$250. Board consensus was to wait until program has been in use to work out initial problems.

One building permit issued to Donald Ley for a shed. No dog report.

County has forwarded a complaint regarding the messiness of Ron Chamber's property inhabited by Jon Carl. Board will look into it.

Supervisor Reinart reported that the culvert by Miller and Sherwood is backing up and needs replacement. The East stop sign on Ballard Road at the Pray intersection has been spray painted. The culvert put in on Michael Hohenstein's driveway does not meet the 16' finished width. He will be notified by the Board of the non-compliance.

Board discussed repair of the shop gutters, insulation of the anterior cement slab, and septic repair.

**Steve Canfield moved / Dale Reinart 2nd, to approve \$1000 for the purchase of 2 laptops for the clerk and treasurer. Carried.**

Budget was reviewed, and adjustments will make it possible to stay within the road budget while repairing the bridge and doing necessary road work.

Chairman will contact Sherwood chairman Andy Cegielski and work toward an agreement on plowing Meridian and Poertner roads.

**Chairman has received a request for granting a permit on Pray Ave which is now a Class B road. Dale moved / Steve Canfield 2nd, that no permits will be granted to any parties for Pray Road. Voice vote – all yes.**

Washout on Sherwood will be corrected tomorrow.
