BOARD MEETING

A Town Board Meeting was called to order on June 8, 2015 by Chairman Gene Huth. Roll call was taken. Present were Huth, Supervisor Canfield, Supervisor Reinart, treasurer Shawn Huth, clerk Donna Kuhn, and 8 residents. The agenda was legally noticed and approved.

The minutes from last month's meeting were read by the clerk and approved. Treasurer's report was read and accepted. No building permits issued. No dog report.

Clerk asked for approval to have computer updated and to purchase a new battery for it.

Supervisor Reinart reported that he has spoken to Dick Vine regarding the condemning of the Cunningham bridge on Pray Ave. Repair will be needed before heavy use can occur.

Steve Canfield moved / Dale Reinart 2nd, to raise election workers wages to \$10 / hour. Voice vote – all yes.

Dale Reinart moved / Steve Canfield 2nd, to approve assessor's contract of \$3100 for 2016. Voice vote – all yes.

The Cunningham Bridge on Pray Ave has been condemned to 10 Ton. Replacement will not be able to take place by the state for an estimated 6 – 7 years. An estimate of \$39,050 has been received by Larson Construction Co for repair and for \$3900 from CORRE Inc for engineering services. Chairman will check into the cost of borrowing \$20,000 to help fund this unexpected repair. **Steve Canfield moved / Dale Reinart 2nd, to accept the estimate bid of from Larson Construction for up to \$40,000 for the repair of the Cunningham Bridge on Pray Ave. Huth – yes, Canfield – yes, Reinart – yes. Carried.**

Reinart moved / Canfield 2nd, to replace the Cunningham Bridge on Pray Ave as soon as possible, and as state / county funding is approved. Huth – yes, Canfield – yes, Reinart – yes. Carried.

Public input: Tony Suda asked Board if the culvert permit he got from the board last year is still valid, and it is. Suda assured the board that the culvert will be installed properly!

Paige Greiger asked the board about how to obtain a burning permit. These can be obtained from the DNR website.

Dean Gaede brought up that visibility was an issue on Carlyle and Owen intersection. Canfield will talk to landowner Sam Matthias regarding clearing it.

Bills examined and paid.
