BOARD MEETING

A Town Board Meeting was called to order on December 20, 2016 by Chairman Dale Reinart. Roll call was taken. Present were Reinart, Supervisor Canfield, treasurer Shawn Huth, clerk Donna Kuhn, patrol Rick Sebesta, and 8 residents. The agenda was legally noticed and approved.

The minutes from last month's meeting were read by the clerk and approved. Treasurer's report was read and accepted. Treasurer received a payment on the Hansen bill. Treasurer also mentioned a program available to be used with taxes for purchase. Will discuss at next month's meeting.

No building permits issued.

Oak wilt issue is progressing. Stumps will be burned soon.

No ditching or graveling was done this fall. Remaining money budgeted for road maintenance will be used next year.

Atkins bill is still inactive. Treasurer will send a final 30 day notice and if it is not paid, will turn it over to the state collection fund.

Canfield moved / Reinart 2nd, to sell the wooden chairs for \$5.00 each. Carried.

Chairman made the request that the Town purchase a truck for roadwork and checks. He will check on purchase price for Gene Huth's old truck and it will be discussed at next month's meeting.

Ban Bautch had offered to help Jerald Sebesta with plowing snow if needed in an emergency.

All road maintenance is postponed until next year.

Bills approved and paid.
