BOARD MEETING

A Town Board Meeting was called to order on July 11, 2016 by Chairman Gene Huth. Roll call was taken. Present were Huth, Supervisor Reinart, Supervisor Canfield, treasurer Shawn Huth, clerk Donna Kuhn, Ed Kuhn, Tony Suda and Pete Hellios. The agenda was legally noticed and approved.

The minutes from last month's meeting were read by the clerk and approved. Treasurer's report was read and accepted. One outstanding fire call bill.

One building and one driveway permit.

Clerk reported no price on data storage yet, but working on that with Ben Poppy. Workman's Comp case has been paid and closed.

Supervisor Reinart mentioned downed tree on Sherwood needs to be cut back. County has now approved culvert on Pray Road just south of 73 for replacement. Estimated cost is \$5000.

Selling of old wooden chairs tabled until more information is obtained on value.

Tony Suda recommended that tree trimming in ROW be earmarked in the budget. Board has been consistently clearing them from ROW as money allows. He also mentioned the success of the decomposed gravel experiment. Board will consider using more decomposed red rock as budget allows.

Extra dust control was spread on Miller and Sherwood Road on newer gravel. The Board hopes this will maintain the fines and give the gravel a longer lifespan.
