BOARD MEETING

A Town Board Meeting was called to order on June 13, 2016 by Chairman Gene Huth. Roll call was taken. Present were Huth, Supervisor Reinart, treasurer Shawn Huth, clerk Donna Kuhn, Ed Kuhn, Carol Bennett and Jim Olin. The agenda was legally noticed and approved.

The minutes from last month's meeting were read by the clerk and approved. Treasurer's report was read and accepted. Papers for the new accounts for the equipment fund, bridge fund, and tax checking account at Citizens State Bank were signed. Supervisor Canfield arrived to also sign the papers.

No building or driveway permits. Ed Kuhn contacted Brian Friemoth regarding questions.

Huth moved / Reinart 2nd, that the Town contract with a provider to supply the Town with off-site storage for technology and computer data. Voice vote – all yes. Carried. Clerk will follow up and get more information on costs and services.

Road maintenance: Tree north of Cunningham needs to be removed. Road will need to be shut down. County did not approve Pray Ave culvert.

Reinart moved / Huth 2nd, to sell old culverts at \$5 / foot. Voice vote – all yes. Carried.

Huth will find a price for selling of old wooden chairs.

Huth moved / Reinart 2nd, to accept Assessor's contract of \$3200 with Becker Appraising for 2017 tax assessment. Voice vote – all yes. Carried.

Pray Avenue brush clearing has been complete with branches remaining in the ditch ground up. Huth was injured by a stick thrown by the grinder. Workman's comp claim filed.

Public Input: Carol Bennett stated that Miller Avenue has bad washboarding.
