BOARD MEETING

A Town Board Meeting was called to order at 7pm on Tuesday, August 13, 2019. Roll call was taken. Present were Board members: Chairman Dale Reinart, Supervisor Ken Kuhn, Supervisor Ed Kuhn, and clerk Donna Kuhn. Treasurer Shawn Huth arrived after clerk's report. Also present were patrol Jerald Sebesta and Jerald Lincoln. The agenda was legally noticed and approved.

Driveway permit was issued to Robert DeVine. Cabin permit issued to Randy Sebesta.

Minutes of July's meeting were approved. Clerk asked for budget items for 2020 budget. GAFR thanked the Town for their annual donation. Fall WTA workshop dates were reviewed.

Jerald Lincoln requested ditching on Pray Road from Pineview intersection south past the trees to his blueberry field. The ditch had been cleaned out from the intersection south part of the way in 2008. The water builds up there and flows into his fields. This will be put on next months agenda.

ROW at Hwy 73 and Miller Ave Contamination *continuing obligations letter* from the DNR was reviewed.

Treasurer's report was accepted. Treasurer will transfer \$30,000 into the bridge project fund as per budget. Outstanding bills were reviewed. Treasurer will follow up with Wilson bill with a letter. Linda Garrett will be sent a final 30 day notice.. If there is no response, it will be sent to the State Debt Collection.

It was noted that dust control is failing on some roads. The large amount of rainfall and moisture this year may be the cause. Board will take note and watch effectiveness in the future.

Trees need to be cut in ROW by Gary Spiegel. Board will talk to him before doing any cutting.

New fire signs are installed. **Ed Kuhn moved / Ken Kuhn 2nd, that emergency signs must be kept visible by the property owner. It will not be the Town's responsibility to keep them visible. All Yes. Carried.** This will be put in tax information sheet.

Board reviewed areas that need tree and limb clean-up.

JJ Brush Cutting will be notified to cut old dump site this fall.

Board was informed that the GAFA increased their budget for 2020 by 5%.

Ed Kuhn moved / Ken Kuhn 2nd, to accept ProVision's LP contract bid of \$1.19/gal for 1000 gallons for the 2019-2020 season. All Yes. Carried.

Pray Ave bridge ROW acquisition footage of 2265 square feet (0.052 acres) was attained from property owners Dennis and Marilyn Spiegel. They were paid \$250 for the land.

Town will change from getting dog rabies vaccination information from the owner's form to requiring that the owner provide a copy of the vaccination as proof for licensing the dog. This request will be added to the dog licensing information that is sent with the taxes.

Bills approved and paid.
