BOARD MEETING

A Town Board Meeting was called to order at 7pm on Monday, May 14, 2019. Roll call was taken. Present were Chairman Dale Reinart, Supervisor Ed Kuhn, Supervisor Ken Kuhn, treasurer Shawn Huth, clerk Donna Kuhn, and one guest (representing Paul Bugar Trucking.) The agenda was legally noticed and approved.

Board opened sealed bids for 2019 gravel:

Opelt G&S: \$10.70 / yd

Paul Bugar: \$8.03 / ton or \$12.05 / yd

Board noted that last year there was not enough binder. This will need to be mentioned if his bid is accepted. Board dismissed Opelt's bid due to this contractor proving themselves to be an irresponsible bidder over the last several years. (See references in former meeting minutes.)

Ken Kuhn moved / Ed Kuhn 2nd, to accept Bugar Trucking's bid. Carried. Board will ask Bruger if residents can get gravel at the same price, but be billed separately from the Town.

Minutes were read and accepted. Treasurer's report was read and accepted. Treasurer will send a certified letter to Linda Garrett with payment options, or the charge will be added to the real estate taxes. Brian Wilson has sent 2 payments toward his bill.

Dale will call Marawood to get shop door post completed. Insulation in shop is finished.

Building permit: Marth Logging, Marathon, (715-842-9200 Ext 249) has applied for a temporary driveway permit for 16x40'. It will be removed at the completion of harvest. They also requested a wt. permit for Pray Ave. **Ed Kuhn moved / Ken Kuhn 2nd, that the Town issue a weight permit for Pray Ave to Marth Logging. Carried.**

Building permit: Joe Kish, W4329 Pineview Road. (608-780-5781)

Clark County Forestry and Parks has awarded the grant for Ballard Road project. Dale will be making contacts.

Emergency signs have been ordered.

Board will wait a few more days for dust control requests to come in.

Tires have been picked up by Auburndale Liberty Recycling.

Repair of V-plow was discussed.

Gravel needs to be cleared out on Pelsdorf Ave from flood damage.

Ed Kuhn moved / Ken Kuhn 2nd, to accept CJ Becker Appraising's bid for 2020 for \$3500. Carried.

Ed Kuhn moved / Ken Kuhn 2nd, to accept JJ Mowing's bid for ditch mowing. Carried.

Ken Kuhn moved / Ed Kuhn 2nd, to renew the Town's insurance with /Rural Mutual. Carried.

Bills approved and paid.
