## Town Budget Hearing

Chairman Dale Reinart opened the Town of Washburn Budget Hearing at the Town Hall at 7:00 p.m. on November 12, 2019. Present were all Town Board members, and Town resident Jim Olin.

The proposed budget for 2020 was presented and reviewed. Questions were answered. **Ken Kuhn moved/ Ed Kuhn 2nd, to close Budget Hearing. Carried.**

## Town Budget Meeting

The Town Budget Meeting was opened immediately following the Hearing, for the purpose of adopting the Road Budget and Town Tax Levy for 2020.

**Jim Olin moved / Ken Kuhn 2<sup>nd</sup>, to adopt the 2020 Town Budget to include \$140,000 for the Road budget and a Town Tax Levy of \$36,628. All present voted YES. Carried.** Ed Kuhn moved / Ken Kuhn 2<sup>nd</sup>, to adjourn the Town Budget Meeting. Carried.

## BOARD MEETING

The November monthly board meeting immediately followed the Budget Meeting. Roll call was taken. All board members were present and the agenda was approved as posted in Town. Minutes were approved as read. Treasurer's report was accepted. Board reviewed outstanding bills. Balance remaining: Garrett - \$600, Wilson - \$300. Treasurer will file with state collections. William Miller will be billed again.

Building permits: Joel Feucht – pole shed. Reinart Dairy – driveway at 1265 Miller Ave. Manuel Andrew – possible cabin.

Clerk's report: The County Grant paperwork for Ballard Road was complete and filed. Reinart and Ed Kuhn will be registered for Highway meeting in Eau Claire on Dec. 2<sup>nd</sup>. No damage has been notice on Pray Road by Opelt Sand and Gravel. Waste / recycling list was reviewed and updated.

2 beaver contracts have been signed for this winter season.

Jim Olin reported garbage being left or blowing out of garbage truck during pick-up. This item has been addressed in the past.

**Ken Kuhn moved / Ed Kuhn 2<sup>nd</sup>, to adopt the 2020 Town Budget with a \$140,000 Road Budget and a Town Tax Levy of \$36,628. All – yes. Carried.**

After review, **Ken Kuhn moved / Ed Kuhn 2<sup>nd</sup>, to approve a Town of Washburn Election Emergency Response Policy. All Yes. Carried.**

The Board reviewed road conditions and updated the WISLR file. Clerk will file with the state. Road maintenance was discussed.

Bills were examined and paid.
