**BOARD MEETING**

A Town Board Meeting was called to order at 7pm on Tuesday, October 8, 2019. Roll call was taken. Present were Board members: Chairman Dale Reinart, Supervisor Ken Kuhn, Supervisor Ed Kuhn, clerk Donna Kuhn, and Treasurer Shawn Huth. Also present were 3 residents and patrol Jerald Sebesta. The agenda was legally noticed and approved.

Minutes were read and approved.

Treasurer's report was read and accepted. Treasurer will transfer \$5000 into the checking account to cover expenses.

Driveway permit was issued to Lee Reinart and Richard Haas.

Town picnic was enjoyed by about 25 attendees. Reviewed for next year's planning.

Chairman announced that Cardinal Ave. South bridge did not pass inspection. It will need to be replaced in appropriately 5 years with an estimate cost of \$140,000 - \$160,000. Chairman approved the 80 / 20 program.

Preliminary budget was reviewed.

Some road ROW need trees trimmed out. Chris Fergusson is willing to cut the trees to keep the firewood. Ed Kuhn will contact Fergusson and have him arrange the cutting with landowners willing to have him do the ROW cutting on their land.
