BOARD MEETING

A Town Board Meeting was called to order at 7 pm on April 21, 2020 by Chairman Dale Reinart. Roll call was taken. Present were Chairman Reinart, Supervisor Ken Kuhn, Supervisor Ed Kuhn, treasurer Shawn Huth, clerk Donna Kuhn, patrol Jerald Sebesta. The agenda was legally noticed and approved.

The minutes from last month's meeting were read by the clerk and approved.

John Bergman from Marth Construction requested road permit for Pray Ave. **Ed Kuhn moved / Ken Kuhn 2nd, to approve permit for John Bergman for 2 vehicles, with the same conditions as last year's permit. All yes. Carried.**

County road bans will be lifted Apr. 22. Town will lift road bans on April 24.

Treasurer's report was read and accepted. William Miller's bill is completely paid. There was no response from Martin Cooper.

No building permits. Scott Rachu of N1524 Owen Ave, has inquired about the size of a culvert, but has not applied for a permit.

Clerk reviewed upcoming meeting dates for Annual meeting on Saturday to meet to adjourn, and for BOR on May 9.

UDC Building Inspector options tabled until next month so more information can be gathered.

Stop signs on Sherwood / Pray and Ballard / Pray intersections have been defaced with stickers. Board will attempt to remove them. Other signs around Town that need replacing or attention were addressed.

The Clark County Forestry and Parks Dept 2020 Road Grant denied Washburn's application for West Ballard.

Culvert on Sherwood needs to be replaced.

Board reviewed all Town road conditions. They discussed and prioritized 2020 road projects. Board estimated gravel need to be 6000 yds. The Town will accept and open bids for road gravel at the next Town meeting on May 19 at 7:00 pm.

Bills approved and paid.
