

# August 11, 2020

## BOARD MEETING

A Town Board Meeting was called to order at 7 pm on August 12, 2020 by Chairman Dale Reinart. Roll call was taken. Present were Chairman Reinart, Supervisor Ken Kuhn, Supervisor Ed Kuhn, clerk Donna Kuhn, Treasurer Shawn Huth, patrol Jerald Sebesta, and Jim Olin. Also present was Dave Wagner. The agenda was legally noticed and approved.

Wagner has trapped and was paid for 2 more beavers.

Minutes from the June Board meeting were read and approved. Treasurer's report was accepted as read.

No building permits.

Clerk reported on upcoming meetings and the Town's budget to date.

Supervisors reported on culverts. Hainz will reset high culvert on Ballard. Tractor damage on Pray Ave was repaired. GAFA levy will increase their 2021 budget by \$397.

Board reviewed policy for expense reimbursement for Board purchases. Adjustments will be made and it will be addressed next month.

Town's Fall Tire and Recycling event will be held in Washburn. Date was set for October 3 from 9am – noon.

Preliminary picnic planning was done for September 26, starting at 11:00 with potluck at noon.

**Ken Kuhn moved, Ed Kuhn 2<sup>nd</sup>, to accept ProVision's bid of \$1.09/gal for 1000 gal. Contract will require 20% down. All Yes. Carried.**

Truck repair estimate was more than expected. Board will try to get a bid for under \$3000.

Ken Kuhn will send Bugar a letter regarding an extra charge in his bill for 5 loads totalling 105 ton.

Road maintenance was discussed.

Bills approved and paid.

Public Input: Jim Olin reported that the traffic on Miller Ave south was excessive and traveling at speeds exceeding 45 mph. Board concluded this was because the Pray Ave bridge is out because of the repair and traffic was using Miller Ave as a detour. The problem should hopefully rectify when the bridge is repaired.
