BOARD MEETING

A Town Board Meeting was called to order at 7 pm on January 14, 2020 by Supervisor Ken Kuhn.

Roll call was taken. Present were Supervisor Ken Kuhn, Supervisor Ed Kuhn, treasurer Shawn Huth, clerk Donna Kuhn, patrol Jerald Sebesta, and Lynn Mueller. Absent was Chairman Dale Reinart. The agenda was legally noticed and approved.

The minutes from last month's meeting were read by the clerk and approved.

Lynn Mueller reported to the Board on the beavers he has been trapping, and their locations. Mueller was paid for 6 beavers that he has caught to date.

Treasurer's report was read and accepted. Accounts receivable were reviewed. Treasurer has received first payment of \$100 from William Miller. Martin Cooper has not been billed yet for October fire but treasurer will begin this month. Treasurer will follow up with state collections for Wilson and Garret.

No building permits.

Clerk will register 3 for the WTA district meeting held in Marshfield next month. Ed Kuhn will talk to Brian Duall about culvert aid application and deadline.

Board reviewed snowplowing and trees removed from road due to heavy snowfall. Emergency signs needed at field roads throughout the Town. Board will table until road review meeting in April.

Waste and Recycling billing policy reviewed:

All permanent residents will be billed at the Town's full annual fee. Residents who travel seasonally but still reside in the Town for 6 or more months are considered full time residents and will be billed the Town's full annual fee. Residents who build a new residence or move into a residence that was previously vacant will be charged a prorated fee according to the service that was provided to them. If residents do not use the service, they will be billed as per above since the Town has provided them service. This policy has been made by the Town based on State Statutes requirements that the Town provide these services. Town recycling tonage weight is monitored by the State and State quotas are required to be met.

Reviewed dog information required for licensing and how to best receive the information from owners.
