BOARD MEETING

A Town Board Meeting was called to order at 7 pm on September 8, 2020 by Chairman Dale Reinart. Roll call was taken. Present were Chairman Reinart, Supervisor Ken Kuhn, Supervisor Ed Kuhn, clerk Donna Kuhn, and Treasurer Shawn Huth. Also present was Dave Wagner. The agenda was legally noticed and approved.

Wagner has trapped, and was paid for 2 more beavers.

Minutes from the August Board meeting were read, corrected, and approved. Treasurer's report was accepted as read.

No building permits.

Clerk reported on upcoming meetings and the Town's budget to date. Town equalization value has been reported by the state as increasing 1.7%. County apportionment has stayed the same.

Bill Wynen's culvert at W3126 Sherwood Rd, was put in by Mike Opelt to flow East instead of West. Ed Kuhn spoke with contractor and informed him of the mistake. If culvert fails, contractor will be responsible for correcting it. Land owner is also aware of the situation. (Wynen's number: 920-475-1699)

Supervisors reported that Hainz has reset the high culvert on Ballard. Board discussed cost for tires at the Fall Town cleanup to be held at Washburn. Prices adjusted. Supervisors also reported that some signs were still being pecked by birds. Supervisors reviewed the Sept. 1st truck accident on Pray Ave. 14 Town hours will be billed out to Ace Material Placing, owner of the vehicle.

Board reviewed Resolution Policy R2020-3. Because of a typo error, resolution will be addressed again next month.

Board discussed 2020 tax levy. There is not a need for a levy resolution increase beyond the state levy limit.

Billing discrepancy with Bugar Trucking will be tabled until next month. There has been no response from Bugar regarding the letter inquiring about the difference.

Road maintenance was discussed.

Bills approved and paid.
